AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
EAST WINDSOR, NEW JERSEY, TO  
ESTABLISH SALARIES AND WAGES FOR THE  
POLICE SUPERIOR OFFICERS' ASSOCIATION UNION  
FOR FISCAL YEARS 2010-2012
