# ORDINANCE 2018 - 02 TOWNSHIP OF EAST WINDSOR COUNTY OF MERCER

# AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST WINDSOR, NEW JERSEY, TO ESTABLISH SALARIES AND WAGES FOR THE TEAMSTERS LOCAL 469 UNION FOR FISCAL 2016, FISCAL 2017, FISCAL 2018 AND FISCAL 2019

**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Township Council of the Township of East Windsor, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, that employees of the Township in the Teamsters Local 469 Union shall be paid the following salaries and wages during years 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019 as itemized in Section 1. Schedule of Salaries and until a successor Ordinance is adopted.

The above salaries reflect 469 members received one and one-half (1.5%) percent increase in salary for the calendar year 2016, a one and three-quarters (1.75%) percent increase for calendar year 2017, a two (2.0%) percent increase for calendar year 2018 and a two (2.0%) percent increase in calendar year 2019.

## **SECTION 3. LONGEVITY**

Longevity pay will apply to all employees after completion of five (5) consecutive years from date of first employment or prior public service. Longevity pay will be paid as a lump sum in the first pay in November of each year on a pro-rated basis from the anniversary date to the date of payment according to the following schedule:

Employees hired on or after September 1, 2014 shall not be eligible for longevity benefit payments.

## **SECTION 4. GENERAL**

Employees shall be compensated according to the 40 – hour work week.

#### **SECTION 5.**

All Ordinances and Resolutions inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

## **SECTION 6.**

Except as otherwise provided, rates of compensation provided herein are in effect retroactive to January 1, 2016.

#### **SECTION 7.**

This Ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days after final passage and publication according to law and shall remain in effect until amended or suspended.
